

The file you see is the configuration and usage guide for the Sweet template module. This document aims to explain the steps in a simple and clear manner, with pictures.


Please follow along with us:

After installing the template module Sweet, go to the "Modules" folder and then enter "SmartPlugins.Themes.Sweet" folder.


Then run the "create-deployed-symlinks" file.




After running this file, the Sweet folder will be automatically created in the theme folder.




Then go to the admin panel and proceed as shown in the image:






Now, follow the images below for active widgets and using the modules:



Now that the template is installed and all the modules are ready, you need to add your information to the template. In the image below, all the sections of the template we have prepared are highlighted separately.


For an explanation of each section, refer to the corresponding section:

Follow these steps the Admin Panel to add your personal logo:







"Menu Plus" can be activated whether you have already created a category or intend to create a new one. To activate Menu Plus, follow these steps:






To create a simple slider, follow the steps below:









#### 6. Category Design:
